Completely focussed on her art career, the artist already has 13 solo shows to her credit as well as participating in many group exhibitions and private commissions.

Her work explores the relationship between representation and abstraction with a technique that is constantly evolving and growing. Combining observation of landscapes with the condensed impressions of my memories, the work combines perception, emotion and expression with a sensitive concern for painterly qualities.
